STAY-AT-HOME EXECUTIVE ORDER

THIS ORDER APPLIES TO EVERY PERSON IN THE STATE OF MARYLAND

The Executive Order **ALLOWS** travel for essential activities to:



Seek Medical Attention



Purchase Supplies for Animals

Businesses that provide necessities for pets or livestock.



Businesses

To purchase groceries, cleaning or laundry supplies and prescriptions.



Care for Family

- Care and transport for family, friends, pets or livestock for essential health and safety activities.
- Child custody exchanges can still occur.



Educational Institutions

To & from educational institutions to receive meals or instructional materials.



Restaurants

For carry-out or drive-thru pick-up.

Essential Jobs

Employees can travel to essential jobs as designated by the Governor, such as healthcare workers, public safety and grocery stores.



Outdoor Exercise Activities

No gatherings of more than 10 people and must follow social distancing guidelines.



The Executive Order DOES NOT:

- **Impose a Curfew**
No restriction on what time a person can leave their home/residence or where a person can travel around the state for essential activities.
- **Impose a Quarantine**
- **Prevent Travel Outside the State**
(self-quarantine is recommended if extended time is spent in a state outside our region)
- **Require Documentation to Travel for Essential Activities**
