

Stay-At-Home Order Enforcement

As we continue to fight this health crisis, the Prince George's County Police Department is moving to **ENGAGE, INFORM & ENCOURAGE** when it pertains to County residents following Governor Hogan's **STAY-AT-HOME Order**.



ENGAGE

Officers will approach and speak to those in violation of the Governor's Executive Order.

ENCOURAGE

Officers will encourage those in non-compliance to disperse and go home. If the person does not comply with the directive, the officer will advise that a violation of the Executive Order is punishable as a misdemeanor and could result in an arrest.

2.



INFORM

Officers will advise the person of the conduct that violates the Executive Order and the need to comply to protect their health and the health of those in the community.



4. ENFORCE

If, after all reasonable efforts have been made to obtain compliance and the person(s) continues with noncompliance, enforcement actions may be taken, to include arrest.
