

# Be **WISE** IMMUNIZE

## Eligibility Guide to Immunizations for Your Child:

The Prince George's County Health Department offers immunizations for children ages 2 months to 18 years old. Your **child's insurance status determines if they are eligible to participate** in the Vaccines for Children program.

### Yes, Full Coverage

*If your child's health insurance covers vaccinations:*

Call your primary care provider or your insurance company to schedule an appointment for your child's immunizations.

### Yes, Medicaid

*If your child has Medicaid insurance:*

Call the Health Department at **(301) 583-3300** to make an appointment for your child's immunizations.

*If your child is an American Indian or Alaska Native, they are eligible for the Vaccines for Children program.*

Call **(301) 583-3300** for an appointment.

### Yes, But it Doesn't Cover Immunizations

*If your child's health insurance does not cover immunizations for your child:*

OR

If your child's insurance covers immunizations but has a fixed dollar amount or cap for immunizations, call one of the clinics below once that fixed dollar amount is reached.
