dining at 50% capacity)



Outdoor Community Pools
(public and private at 25% capacity)



Child Care
Childcare Facilities
(for essential workers and
phase two employees
returning to work)



Houses of Worship
(indoor services at 25%
capacity, outdoor services
up to 250 people)



Outdoor Youth Sports
(small groups, no more than
9 children and 1 coach)



Car Washes with
Automated Systems
(self-service now allowed)



Parks
(personal fitness and
fitness classes)
