Prince George's County Modified Phase Two Reopening

Prince George's County will enter a modified phase two reopening June 15, 2020 at 5:00 PM.

We encourage all residents to use good judgment and limit non-essential trips.

What is Now Open with Modifications:



Retail Stores (in-store at no more than 50% capacity)



Barbershops/Hair Salons (by appointment only at 50% capacity)



Nail Salons (by appointment only, 1 customer per 200 sq. ft.)



Restaurants (outdoor seating, indoor dining at 50% capacity)





Childcare Facilities (for essential workers and phase two employees returning to work)



Houses of Worship (indoor services at 25% capacity, outdoor services up to 250 people)



Outdoor Youth Sports (small groups, no more than 9 children and 1 coach)



Car Washes with
Automated Systems
(self-service now allowed)



Parks
(personal fitness and fitness classes)

What Remains CLOSED/Activities not Permitted:



- Indoor pools
- Gyms, fitness centers and other indoor physical activities
- County Government buildings
- Tattoo parlors

- Spas/Massage parlors
- Amusement parks
- Casinos
- Enclosed shopping malls
