PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING ANNOUNCEMENT

The Prince George's County Department of Public Works and Transportation (DPW&T) is in the process of designing roadway improvements for Montpelier Drive, from MD-197 to south of Carland Place, which will enhance the safety of the roadway. The selected design is based on feedback and input received from the community during the public meeting held in the Summer of 2016.

You are invited to attend a Public Information Meeting on October 5th 2017, between 6:30 and 8:30 p.m. at the Deerfield Run Elementary School-Gymnasium at 1300 Laurel Bowie Road, Laurel, MD 20708. DPW&T appreciates the opportunity to review the design and discuss project-related issues with the residents.


At the public information meeting, you will have the opportunity to understand the project design, learn about the upcoming construction schedule, ask questions and provide comments. Maps and visual information about the project will be displayed. In addition, Prince George's County DPW&T staff will be available to answer your questions. Please feel free to arrive at any time during meeting hours and walk through the display area at your own pace.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

The primary objective of the Montpelier Drive Complete Street Improvement Project is traffic calming/speed reduction. This will be achieved via the construction of raised medians, and incorporating bicycle lanes within the travel lanes while maintaining adequate parking and access to all residents' properties. The purpose of this project is to improve the safety of the roadway and accommodate all principal modes of transportation, walking, biking and driving.


PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

Project improvements will include raised medians for traffic calming, curb extensions to create a reduced crossing distance for pedestrians, and new pavement markings to designate travel, bicycle, and parking lanes. Other improvements will include a complete repaving of the roadway, replacement of deteriorated sidewalks and driveway aprons, new high-visibility signage, and the installation of drainage inlets and underdrains, where needed. The project will also include replacing high-risk, dead and diseased trees such as Bradford Pear trees, with sturdier trees.
