Overview

Laurel-Beltsville Oasis is a Youth Services Bureau administered by the Prince George's County Health Department since 1973. Oasis provides programs for children, youth, and their families in the Laurel and surrounding areas of Prince Georges County.

MISSION

We are committed to **prevent** juvenile delinquency, **promote** positive youth development and **strengthen** family functioning. Oasis is designed to provide early intervention and prevention services to at-risk youth who are experiencing emotional problems and or difficulties with their family, school, and community.

COST

Services are provided on a sliding fee scale and medical assistance is accepted.

STAFF

Oasis staff includes licensed clinical professional counselors with extensive experience working with children, teens, and families.

Spanish-speaking staff is available.

REFERRALS

Referrals are accepted from all sources including schools, family, friends, self, the Department of Social Services and the Department of Juvenile Services.

All services are strictly confidential.

Counseling

Laurel-Beltsville Oasis has experienced, caring staff that are ready to work with you and your child. Your child may benefit from counseling if he or she has been experiencing the following;

- A decline in school performance
- Frequent school suspensions
- Trouble concentrating
- Family conflict
- Behavioral problems
- Anxiety
- Anger
- Depression
- Substance use
- Cutting and other self-injurious behaviors

Laurel-Beltsville Oasis provides

- Family Therapy
- Individual Counseling
- Anger Management,
- Bullying/ Victimization Prevention
- Parenting Support Services
- Crisis Intervention
- Suicide Prevention
- Substance Abuse Assessment
- Information and Referral Services

Other supplementary services are provided to clients as special needs arise in the community. Call Oasis for further information.

Funding
