It is imperative that campers be dropped off on time by 8:30am as some mornings we will be leaving the camp site. We will return to at 4:00pm. Please be aware that we are not able to provide before and after care. If you are late picking your child up more than twice, we reserve the right to terminate your child’s involvement in the camp. Campers will be required to bring a bag lunch daily. If there are any complications please do not hesitate to call.

Campers should dress appropriately for outdoor activities. Campers should wear tennis shoes and socks (that they don’t mind getting dirty), an appropriate length shorts and t-shirt that does not display any messages that can be viewed as obscene or offensive. As a safety precaution, flip-flops or sliders will not be allowed, except for the day of canoeing and the water park. All kids should bring the following daily; bathing suit (preferably a one piece for girls) towel, sun screen, tennis shoes and water shoes we also suggest a change of clothes.

Electronic devices, with the exception of cell phones are prohibited. Cell phone use will be restricted to breaks and lunch. Please be mindful that we will be spending a lot of time outdoors.
