

### YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Complete application and receive approval prior to beginning your project.
- Inform and obtain support of the landowner or management agency.
- 3 Inform and obtain support of maintenance and grounds crews, if relevant.
- Reach out to community members.
- 5 Involve groups like environmental clubs, master gardeners or naturalists.
- Pay for the project upfront and get reimbursed later. Submit documentation showing that the project has been paid in-full.
- Contact MISS Utility.
- B Develop a maintenance plan to include:
  - A Responsible party who will take care of the plants year-round for 2 years.
  - B Description of how you will ensure that the plants will be watered at least every 7 days during dry periods.
  - C Identification of nearby water access or a plan to obtain water access near the intended planting site.
  - Replacement schedule for any plants that do not survive the first two (2) years.
- Obtain and submit three written cost estimates for the plant material.
- 10 Submit locational information and pictures of the trees that were planted.
- Allow the County to assess tree survivability within a year of the planting and then every three years thereafter.
