Vision Zero is a goal to create safe roads that support all ages and abilities!

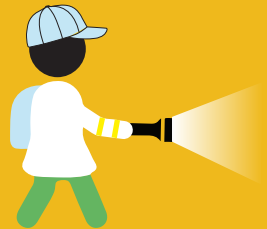
Bike Safety

- Always wear a buckled helmet.
- Always stop at stop signs, lights, and intersections.
- Always look both ways when crossing the road.



Walking Safety

- Always look left, right, and left again before crossing the road.
- Stay on sidewalks and cross the street at crosswalks.
- Wear something bright and carry a light. Be seen and be safe.
- Phones down, eyes up, and pay attention.



Take the Vision Zero Safety Pledge for Teens and Kids!

- ✓ I will look left, right and left again to make sure it's clear before crossing the street.
- ✓ I will stay on sidewalks and cross the street at crosswalks whenever possible.
- ✓ I will walk and bike alert, free of distractions and with eyes on the road.
- ✓ I will wear bright white or reflective clothing so drivers can see me when walking or biking.
- ✓ When biking, I will always wear a helmet.
- ✓ When in a car, I will always wear my seatbelt and ask others to buckle up too.
- ✓ I will share the Vision Zero pledge with my friends and family!
