

WebEOC User Training

WebEOC is a web-enabled collaborative crisis information management system designed to provide real-time situational awareness to any authorized user, anywhere. WebEOC status boards provide the ability to create, post, transmit, and share information real-time among other WebEOC users. This application is used to support the management of all-hazards incidents or planned events.

This is a one day entry level class designed to teach new WebEOC users how to effectively use and operate the application. *This class may also be taken as a refresher course.* The training provided is a series of interactive lessons. Participants will gain a basic understanding of how WebEOC is used to support all phases of an incident management during an emergency, exercise, or event.

This course will cover the login process, control panel functions and indicators, information displays, status boards, use of tools and plug-ins, adding information, and the use of position logs.

Who should take WebEOC?

Individuals with multi-agency coordination system responsibilities or may serve in an agency or departmental command center. Personnel who may serve in the County Emergency Operations Center or who serve as agency/departmental emergency managers, coordinators, or liaisons should attend. Persons responsible for incident/event management policy development or coordination and those responsible for coordination of response resources with regional, state or federal response partners should attend this course.
