- **Workflow Designer** — Allows applicants and staff to view where they are in the process and to understand the overall process flow.
- **Reporting** — Enhanced features allow more detailed reports for both applicants and staff.
- **Checklists** and **Comments** — Enhanced features assist applicants to better understand requirements.
