COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 1-2026

Date: March 3, 2026

WHEREAS, Prince George's County, Maryland, a body corporate and politic, has entered into Agreements with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for Community Development Block Grant funds in conformity with the provisions of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, P.L. 93-383, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) has been charged with the responsibility of administering the Community Development Block Grant Program ("CDBG"); and

WHEREAS, the Department of Social Services ("DSS") applied and was awarded PY51 CDBG funds ("Grant funds") for the purpose of administering its "Elder and Vulnerable Adult Abuse – Respite Care and Emergency Placement Services" as described in the County's Annual Action Plan ("AAP") as submitted to HUD for County Fiscal Year 2026 (CDBG Program Year ("PY") 51); and

WHEREAS, the County Executive of Prince George's County has by Executive Order No. 49-1986 and Executive Order 28-2002 delegated authority to the Chief Administrative Officer to direct County agencies and departments to administer identified government projects and activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Section I. The above-referenced recitals are hereby incorporated by reference.

Section II. DSS is hereby authorized and directed to administer the "Elder and Vulnerable Adult Abuse and Respite Care and Emergency Placement Services" ("Program") as described in the County's FY 2026 Annual Action Plan for PY51 and the Interagency CDBG Agreement ("Agreement") between DHCD and DSS, which is attached and hereby incorporated by reference.

Section III. DSS is further authorized to oversee and inspect all services provided by contractors and/or subcontractors in accordance with the Program, this Order and all applicable State, local and federal laws, codes and regulations.

Section IV. This Order shall remain in effect until such time the Program is completed, DHCD or DSS terminates the Agreement or HUD provides notice that funds are no longer available to support services provided in conjunction with the Program.
