In the matter of **t/a Hook & Reel (Iverson Mall)**, located at 3823 Branch Avenue, Temple Hills, 20748. See email dated June 25, 2025, regarding a request to approve an extension to August 31, 2025, to effectuate the license. The establishment needs additional time to ensure the Final Inspection is approved and the Certificate of Occupancy can be issued. (*3rd request*) The Commissioners voted by unanimous consent to approve an extension to August 31, 2025, to effectuate the license.

In the matter of **t/a Free State Distillery**, 1001 Prince Georges Blvd, Ste 200, Upper Marlboro, 20774. See letter dated June 30, 2025, regarding a request to extend the distillery permit to include a 400 sq. ft. parking space directly in front of the distillery. The extension is requested for a Summer Sunset Series of events to be held on selected dates, Friday and Saturday nights from 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM between July 11, 2025, and November 1, 2025, as outlined in the letter.

The Commissioners voted by unanimous consent to approve the request to extend the distillery permit to include a 400 sq. ft. parking space directly in front of the distillery. The extension is requested for a Summer Sunset Series of events to be held on selected dates, Friday and Saturday nights from 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM between July 11, 2025, and November 1, 2025.

In the matter of **t/a Strick's Restaurant**, located at 3211 Branch Avenue, Silver Hill, 20748, has an outstanding fine related to a violation that occurred on April 22, 2025. The total amount due is \$750, which includes a \$250 fine and a \$500 late fee. Payment was due by May 29, 2025. Attempts to contact the licensee regarding this matter have been unsuccessful. The Commissioners voted by unanimous consent to continue this matter to the next hearing.

In the matter of **t/a SoBe Restaurant and Lounge**, located at 10621 Greenbelt Road #201, Seabrook, 20706. See letter dated July 2, 2025, regarding a request to extend the patio/outdoor space on July 13, 2025. On that date, the restaurant will be hosting our annual White Party. The licensee is requesting permission to use the adjacent parking lot to expand their seating area. The space measures approximately 60 feet by 90 feet. Due to the expected warm weather, they will not be using a tent or any heating elements. The Commissioners voted by unanimous consent to approve the request for an extension of the patio/outdoor area for July 13, 2025, to accommodate the annual White Party.

In the matter of **t/a Veterans Cigar Club**, located at 6409 Old Alexandria Ferry Road, Clinton, Maryland 20735. See letter dated July 3, 2025, regarding a request to host an outdoor event on the first Wednesday of August, September, and October in celebration of Motorcycle Riding Season. The event will feature outdoor seating, food, live music, and the responsible sale of alcohol following all regulations.
