The first proposed dates are Sunday, August 24, 2025, from 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM, and Monday, September 8, 2025, from 10:00 PM to 1:00 AM. The purpose of adding live entertainment on these days is to enhance the atmosphere for our patrons, attract new customers, and generate increased revenue for the business.
7. **t/a Ebony Inn**, located at 5367 Sheriff Road, Fairmont Heights, 20743. See letter dated July 30, 2025, regarding a request to expand the liquor license to include an adjacent room within the establishment. This additional space features a separate exterior entrance for convenient guest access. To ensure compliance with all applicable

regulations, the room will be monitored by security to confirm that all patrons are at least 21 years of age and to prevent the removal of alcoholic beverages from the licensed area. All alcohol will remain within the newly designated space and will not be transported in or out during service.
