No. 11: Purchases by Authorized Retailer of the Rules and Regulations for Prince George's County.
11. **t/a Hyattsville Spirits and Grill** – Oral argument and status hearing pursuant to the Circuit Court's order remanding the matter to the BOLC, continued from October 8, 2025.
