No. 83 Alcohol Awareness of the Rules and Regulations for Prince George's County.

No. 11 of the Rules and Regulations for Prince George's County: Purchase by Authorized Retailer: No license holder shall purchase any alcoholic beverage except from a duly licensed manufacturer or wholesaler. 20. **National Association of Buffalo Soldiers One Day Event**, located 9407 Livingston Road, Fort Washington, 20744. For an alleged violation of R.R. No. 37-Change of Mode of operation- A. No License holder shall change the mode of operation of the licensed premises without first having the approval and/or consent of the Board of Licensed Commissioners.
