5. Mozuenorinmi P. Okolie, Member-Manager, **t/a Calabar Kitchen and Lounge**, located at 3524 Crain Highway, Bowie, 20716. For an alleged violation of 26-1902. 1. The license holder or an individual designated by the license holder who is employed in a supervisory capacity shall be certified by an approved alcohol awareness program and be present on the licensed premises at all times when alcoholic beverages may be sold of the Alcoholic Beverage Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland and R.R. No. 83 Alcohol Awareness of the Rules and Regulations for Prince George's County.

6. Maria Aguilar, President/Secretary/Treasurer, **t/a Fast Eddies**, located at 4801 Allentown Road, Suitland, 20746. For an alleged violation of R.R. No. 37 of the Rules and Regulations for Prince George's County: ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS- No license holder shall make any alteration or additions to a licensed premises or change the manner in which alcoholic beverages are dispensed without first obtaining permission from the Board. E. In the event a licensee decides to significantly alter the mode of operation and the format of presentation of alcoholic beverages to the public from that contained in the original application approved by the Board at the time of issuance of the license, such change must first be presented to the Board for approval; R.R. No. 58 of the Rules and Regulations for Prince George's County:-RESTAURANT DEFINITION, CLASS B, BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR ESTABLISHMENT- (5) be open during the hours approved by the Board of License Commissioners unless the licensee obtains written permission from the Board to change its hours. Any interruption in the operation of restaurant facilities for any reason must be reported to the Board promptly; and R.R. No. 89 of the Rules and Regulations for Prince George's County:- COMPLIANCE WITH GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITY- Any licensee, including their agents or employees, who fail to comply with, or are found in violation of, any lawful order, rule, executive order, or requirement issued by the Board of License Commissioners; government officials; members of the Police Department, Fire Authorities, Health Department, Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement; Grand Jury; or representatives of authorized agencies, where such directives are, in the judgement of the Board, intended to promote the health, safety, or general welfare of the public, shall be deemed in violation of these regulations.
7. **t/a Hyattsville Spirits and Grill** – Oral argument and status hearing pursuant to the Circuit Court's order remanding the matter to the BOLC, continued from August 5, 2026.
