ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

Correspondence – None.

Gubernatorial Election

- Polling Place Locations – Locations are scheduled for State Board of Elections' (SBE) review and approval on January 18, 2026. The approved list of locations will be posted on-line and affected voters is be notified.
- Ballot Deliveries – The United States Postal Service (USPS) will make ballot deliveries once a day during the election cycle. Voters are urged to return mail ballots via drop boxes, use registered/certified mail options, or return their ballots at least one week prior to Election Day if using USPS regular mail.

Voter Registrations – The Maryland Voter Registration System is updated based on information received from the registrants, ERIC (Electronic Registration Information Center), MVA (Motor Vehicle Administration, NCOA (National Change of Address), and other reports. This report is available on the BOE website.

Facility Renovations – Suite 160 (Training Room) renovations were completed last week.

PERSONNEL

NEW BUSINESS –

Personal Records Notice/Confidentiality Requests – Ms. Honesty-Bey presented two (2) voter confidentiality requests.

- This request was from a transgender individual/member of a vulnerable population with supporting documentation. A motion was made by Ms. Williams, seconded by Dr. Pratt, and duly passed approving this confidentiality request.
- This request was submitted without supporting documentation. A motion was made by Ms. Williams, seconded by Ms. Deegan, and duly passed to defer a decision on this request until we receive additional information.

LEGAL – Mr. Horne reported that the redistricting challenge is scheduled to go to court on January 14, 2026. Based on the outcome of this case, the date of the Gubernatorial Primary Election could be impacted. Does the SBE support the timeline for changes if needed?
