

THIRD-PARTY RESIDENTIAL SOLAR SYSTEMS INSPECTION



BULLETIN 2015-02

February 26, 2020 (**REVISED**)

SUBJECT: Requirements for all Solar Inspections

PURPOSE: To clarify that the Prince George's County Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement (DPIE) allows County approved Third-Party Electrical inspectors to perform solar system inspections under DPIE's Third-Party Inspections Program (TPIP). Solar panel inspections shall be performed in accordance with all applicable Prince George's County Building codes in effect at the time of permit issuance.

AUTHORITY: Director of the Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement

NOTIFICATION: Effective immediately, all solar system installations regardless of cost, both residential and commercial solar shall be inspected and certified by an approved Third-Party Inspector(s). Certifications shall be wet sealed and signed originals (TPIP Attachment #6, or #6s (residential). Of significant note, the Third-Party Inspector cannot be affiliated with the installing contractor.

COMMERCIAL SOLAR PROCEDURE:

Permit applicants are required to submit a Statement of Third-Party Inspections (STPI Attachment #1) as a condition for final inspection; and follow the TPIP Manual.

RESIDENTIAL SOLAR PROCEDURE:

Project designees shall complete and sign a modified Attachment #1S Statement of Third-Party Inspection - Solar, prior to beginning work

Contractor shall complete Attachment #1S included, for each project

Upon completion and inspection of the project, the contractor shall complete and submit an inspection transmittal package to the Commercial Electrical Inspection Section, which includes:

- > Statement of Third-Party Inspection as modified (STPI Attachment #1S)
- ➤ Copies of any interim inspection and testing reports
- Final inspection report from each Third-Party Inspector
- ➤ Modified Third-Party Inspection Program Certification Form Solar (TPIP Attachment #6S)

Electrical Code Official or his/her representative shall review the submittal and shall:

➤ Approved submittals:

- o Scan TPIP Attachment #6S into the attachment section of the permit case
- o Enter a Third-Party Inspection Certification Final Approval in e-Permits
- o Prepare an Electrical Approval Sticker for pickup by the contractor
- Close the case

➤ Rejected submittals:

- o Enter a rejection of Third-Party Certification in e-Permits
- Contact contractor with deficiencies
- Electrical Code Official or his/her representative may take up to (3) three business days to complete the review:
 - o Reviewer reserves the ability to make quality assurance visits and evaluate the work of the Third-Party team
 - Failing quality assurance reviews will result in additional oversight of project, including disqualification from the Program

RESPONSIBILITIES: Responsibilities shall be as follows:

All DPIE Building Code Inspection supervisors shall disseminate a copy of this Bulletin to all Inspections personnel.

DPIE Inspections Quality Assurance personnel shall reject any Third-Party Inspection of a residential solar system not in compliance with the intent and scope of this Bulletin.

ATTACHMENT #1S

STATEMENT OF THIRD-PARTY INSPECTIONS

In an effort to encourage renewable energy and provide timely services to the public, Prince George's County allows the use of qualified third-party inspectors to evaluate the work of solar contractors and report the results of those inspections to the property owner and the County.

Permit applicants are required to submit a Statement of Third-Party Inspections (STPI) as a condition for final inspection. This statement shall certify that all Third-party inspections shall occur in accordance with the Third-Party Inspection Program (TPIP). The STPI shall include a list of the individuals (agents), approved agencies, and firms intended to be retained for conducting such inspections and the function in which each Third-Party Inspector is serving must be clearly designated. AN INDIVIDUAL'S SIGNATURE ON THE STPI CERTIFIES THAT HE/SHE UNDERSTANDS THE ROLE THEY ARE UNDERTAKING IN THE TPIP. Prince George's County reserves the right to require notarization of any signature included in this document.

This Attachment may be used "as is" or modified to accommodate unique requirements of a specific project. The STPI must be submitted with the inspection documents. These pages must identify the location, owner, Third-Party Inspectors of Record (TPIR) and the contractor.

The qualifications of the TPIR are outlined in the THIRD-PARTY SOLAR SYSTEMS INSPECTION BULLETIN. The full definitions and qualifications for an individual referenced in the STPI can be found in the Prince George's County TPIP Manual (pages 2-5 and Attachment #2, page 23). Documentation supporting any individual's qualifications may be requested at any time and is to remain on file with DPIE.

To help assure a complete understanding of responsibilities and reporting requirements, the TPIR identified on this STPI, select DPIE representatives, the prime contractor and other appropriate parties must attend a pre-application conference coordinated by the solar design firm desiring to use this program. Design Engineers of Record are not required to attend this meeting unless directed otherwise by the owner, solar design firm or County representative. This STPI and the qualifications of the TPIR and/or any inspection and testing agency must be reviewed by County Code officials and approved at the pre-application meeting prior to the application of this procedure. Only one (1) pre-application meeting is required annually unless requested by an owner or the County.

NOTE: It must be clearly understood that each TPIR Electrical Inspector of Record (EIR) and Structural Inspector of Record (SIR) selected must be unaffiliated with the Design Engineer of Record (DER) Electrical Engineer of Record (EER), and Structural Engineer of Record (SER) and the installer/contractor. It is assumed that the design professionals will field verify the installation of their design or specification documents; HOWEVER, this verification is not part of the TPIP process.
