CHARGES:

Allegedly, Ms. Florez' large, brown, German Shepherd type dog had bitten Ms. Perry's younger son at the park on March 25, 2026. Ms. Perry states that the attacking dog has a history of running at large and has charged after her older son on November of 2025. This is in violation of Section 3-131 "Manner of Keeping; Prohibition of Nuisances"; Section 3-132 'Public Nuisance Conditions'; Section 3-135 'Animals at large prohibited'; Section 3-136 'Dangerous Animals'; Section 3-142 'Irresponsible Pet Owner'; Section 3-145 "License of Dogs, Cats, and ferrets", and Section 3-182 'Potentially Dangerous Animals'; Section 3-186 'Vaccination of Dogs, Cats, and ferrets'; of the Prince George's County Code.

CHARGES:

The Prince George's County Animal Services Division is requesting a Dangerous dog hearing for the above listed animal. Allegedly on June 14th, 2026, the above listed dog attacked and killed 1 dog. On June 15th, dog owner Mr. Jasper interfered with impounding dog "Chop" and now the whereabouts of the dog is unknown. This is in violation of Section 3-125 "Interference with impounding of animals"; Section 3-132 'Public Nuisance Conditions'; Section 3-136 'Dangerous Animals'; Section 3-142 'Irresponsible Pet Owner'; Section 3-182 'Potentially Dangerous Animals'; and Section 3-186 'Vaccination of Dogs, Cats, and ferrets. Section 3-145 "License of Dogs, Cats, and ferrets' of the Prince George's County Code.

v.

CHARGES:

The City of Greenbelt Animal Services is requesting a dangerous dog hearing for the above listed animal. Allegedly on June 9, 2026, Ms. Price's dog pulled the leash from her hand and attacked Cristian Garcia and his dog. Allegedly on June 12, 2026, Ms. Price's dog nipped Greenbelt Police Officer Upson in the shin while he was assisting Greenbelt Animal Services. Allegedly on June 22, 2026, Ms. Price's dogs were running at large on Ridge Rd unattended. Allegedly on August 5, 2026, Ms. Price's dog pulled the leash from her hand and attacked Tracy Foster and his dog. This is in violation of Section 3-131 (c) 'Manner of Keeping; Prohibition of Nuisance's'; Section 3-132 'Public Nuisance Conditions'; Section 3-135 'Animals at Large Prohibited'; Section 3-136 'Dangerous Animals'; Section 3-142 'Irresponsible Pet Owner'; Section '3-145 'Ferret, dog, and cat licenses'; Section 3-182 'Potentially Dangerous Animals of the Prince George's County Code.

CHARGES:

Allegedly, Mr. Stroy's black, American Pit Bull Terrier mixed dog has a history of running at large and attacking Ms. Fields and her dog. This is in violation of Section 3-131, "Manner of Keeping Animals"; Section 3-132 'Public Nuisance Conditions'; Section 3-135 "Animals at large prohibited." Section 3-136 "Dangerous Animals"; Section 3-142 "Irresponsible Pet Owner"; Section 3-145 "Ferret, dog, and cat licenses", Section 3-186 'Vaccination of Dogs, Cats, and ferrets', and Section 3-182 "Potentially Dangerous Animal" of the Prince George's County Code.

CHARGES:

Allegedly, Mr. Padayao's dog has bitten Ms. Oliver's 16-year-old daughter on August 6, 2026. This is in violation of Section 3-131, "Manner of Keeping Animals"; Section 3-132 'Public Nuisance Conditions'; Section 3-135 "Animals at large prohibited." Section 3-136 "Dangerous Animals"; Section 3-142 "Irresponsible Pet Owner"; Section 3-145 "Ferret, dog, and cat licenses", and Section 3-186 'Vaccination of Dogs, Cats, and ferrets', and Section 3-182 "Potentially Dangerous Animal" of the Prince George's County Code.
