CHARGES:

The Prince George’s County Animal Services Division is requesting a Dangerous dog hearing for the above listed animal(s). From May 3, 2023 until most recently on August 14, 2025 the Animal Services Division has responded to the above address 13 times for issues with running at large, confinement, evaluations, and animal cruelty complaints. This is in violation of Section 3-131 ‘Manner of Keeping; Prohibition of Nuisances’; Section 3-132 ‘Public Nuisance Conditions’; Section 3-135 ‘Animals at large prohibited’; Section 3-142 ‘Irresponsible Pet Owner’; and Section 3-182 ‘Potentially Dangerous Animals’.

v.

CHARGES:

The Prince George’s County Animal Services Division is requesting a Dangerous dog hearing for the above listed animal(s). Allegedly on July 27, 2025, the above listed dogs while running at large and unprovoked attacked Ms. Yigrem on her way home from church. Ms. Yigrem sustained injuries to her right forearm and wrist, left hand, and a scratch on her right cheek that were treated at White Oak Medical Center. This is in violation of Section 3-131 ‘Manner of Keeping; Prohibition of Nuisances’; Section 3-132 ‘Public Nuisance Conditions’; Section 3-135 ‘Animals at large prohibited’; Section 3-136 ‘Dangerous Animals’; Section 3-142 ‘Irresponsible Pet Owner’; and Section 3-182 ‘Potentially Dangerous Animals’.

v.

CHERIE WHITFIELD

CHARGES:

Allegedly, Ms. Whitfield has not been properly containing her medium-sized, white and tan dog in her property; resulting in her dog running at large. Ms. Whitfield's dog has attacked Ms. Elder's dog on multiple occasions, most recently on June 30, 2025. This is in violation of Section 3-131, "Manner of Keeping Animals"; Section 3-132 'Public Nuisance Conditions'; Section 3-135 "Running at large prohibited"; Section 3-136 'Dangerous Animals'; Section 3-142 'Irresponsible Pet Owner'; Section 3-145 'Ferret, dog, and cat licenses'; and Section 3-182 'Potentially Dangerous Animals' of the Prince George's County Code.

No. 167-25 LEAH CHAPMAN

v.

TONYA FLOYD

CHARGES

Allegedly, Ms. Chapman's brown, medium sized dog has been a public nuisance by virtue of excessive barking and has caused an unreasonable annoyance, disturbance, or discomfort to others near the premises where the animal is kept. This is in violation of Section 3-131 'Manner of Keeping Animals', Section 3-132 'Public nuisance conditions and animals; procedures; appeals, Section 3-134 'Excessive noise by an animal prohibited', and Section 3-142 'Irresponsible Owner', of the Prince George's County Code.

No. 102-25 KEN WRIGHT

v.

NHAN T. LE

CHARGES:

Allegedly, Mr. Le's dog has been creating a public nuisance by excessively barking. This is in violation of Section 3-131, "Manner of Keeping Animals"; ; Section 3-132 'Public Nuisance Conditions'; Section 3-134 "Excessive noise by an animal prohibited"; and Section 3-142 "Irresponsible Pet Owner"; of the Prince George's County Code.
