The regular meeting of the Nuisance Abatement Board of Prince George's County Government was called to order at 10:30 AM on December 14, 2023, at Zoom/Virtual Hearings by Shirley Lathern.

# I. Approval of Agenda

## III. Consideration of Open Issues

- 50-23: 1203 Marblewood Avenue Shirley Lathern
   Storage of wrecked, dismantled, or unlicensed vehicles, property maintenance issues, permitting issues, trash & debris, unauthorized signage
- 2. <u>51-23: 8521 Mulberry Street Shirley Lathern</u> Loud noise, trash & debris, openly stored items, unlawful vehicles, trailers and commercial vehicles parked on the property

- 3. 54-23: 13710 Baden Naylor Road Shirley Lathern
  - Ongoing parties & events, loud noise & music, distribution of food & alcohol, trash, large number of attendees, ticket sales, disruption of the neighborhood
- 4. 56-23: 6545 Annapolis Road Shirley Lathern

Business not in good standing with the Sate of Maryland, 28 police calls for service in 5 months, loud noise & music, loud parties, late operating hours, parking issues, violation of Maryland Alcoholic Beverage Code

#### **Decisions**

Each case is deliberated in closed session. The board unanimously voted to declare case **50-23**, **1203 Marblewood Avenue**, a public and neighborhood nuisance; ordered to cease and desist all nuisance activities that constitute a nuisance, immediate closure ordered, not to exceed 1 year. The board unanimously voted to declare case **51-23**, **8521 Mulberry Street**, not a nuisance. The board unanimously voted to declare case **54-23**, **13710 Baden Naylor Road**, a public and neighborhood nuisance; ordered to cease and desist all nuisance activities that constitute a nuisance, immediate compliance ordered. Case **56-23**, **6545 Annapolis Road**, a public and neighborhood nuisance; ordered to cease and desist all nuisance activities that constitute a nuisance, immediate closure ordered until in compliance, at least 9 months. **Case 53-23**, **9329 Limestone Place** has been withdrawn from the docket due to the eviction of the tenant. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 4:30 PM by Shirley Lathern.
