Requirements

Exhibitors can begin setting up at 8:30 a.m. but **MUST** arrive and be set up no later than 9:30 a.m. The main entrance and loading area will be closed off beginning at 9:30 a.m. for pedestrian-only traffic.

This will be strictly enforced. Late arrivals may forfeit their booth space. Exhibitors must stay for the duration of the event. Tables and chairs will be provided for exhibitors. Canopies no larger than 10' x 10' are welcome. Electricity sources will not be available for this outside event.

Cancellations and Exhibitor Fees

The Department of the Environment has the right to cancel the Summit at any time and shall not be held liable for damages, claims, expenses, or losses because of the cancellation. We extend our gratitude for the partners helping make this a success. There are no fees associated with participating in the event.

Liability
