WHEREAS, Prince George's County recognizes the value of work-life balance as a benefit of employment;


WHEREAS, Prince George's County is committed to serving as a model public employer by ensuring customer service for its residents and clients;

WHEREAS, Prince George's County recognizes the need to evolve the Alternative Work Arrangements Program to meet the growing needs of the County;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, effective September 2, 2025, telework has been approved, and all eligible employees may, with the approval of the appointing authority for their agency participate in telework up to one (1) day per week;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, effective September 2, 2025, all new hires shall complete a minimum of ninety (90) days tour of duty in-office prior to being eligible to participate in telework;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, effective September 2, 2025, all Agency Directors shall have an approved front-facing customer service plan. Agency Directors shall have discretion in structuring their customer service plans to meet the unique needs of their respective agencies.
