ENHANCED SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM INVESTMENT JUSTIFICATION APPLICATION (IJA)

As part of the Enhanced Security Grant Program (ESGP) application, eligible organizations must develop a formal Investment Justification Application (IJA) that addresses each project proposed for funding. These IJAs must demonstrate how proposed projects demonstrate the ability to provide security enhancements consistent with the purpose of the program and guidance provided by the Enhanced Security Grant Program Guidelines. Organizations seeking funding for multiple locations MUST submit an IJA for each location/facility.

Prince George's County Government has developed guidelines that establish the required IJA content and helps ensure that submissions are organized in a consistent manner while addressing key data requirements. Failure to address these data elements in the prescribed format could potentially result in the rejection of the IJA from review consideration.

Applications should be submitted by the organization to <u>311onthego@co.pg.md.us</u> as a completed PDF. Supporting documentation MUST be included with the electronic submission.
