







KEEP YOUR PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION SAFE!



Safely store or dispose of any unused and/or unwanted medication to prevent accidental poisonings, prescription misuse, and overdoses. Do your part, keep your family and community safe!

Store medication out of reach and sight, preferably in a locked place. Put it away after each use, keep medication inventory, and consider a lock box.

Safely dispose of unused/unwanted medication:

Mix unused/unwanted medication with wet cat litter or coffee grounds in a sealable bag and throw it in the trash. **DO NOT FLUSH**; flushing harms our waterways.

Attend National Prescription Drug Take Back Day on the last Saturday of April and October. This event allows you to drop off any unused/unwanted medications, vapes, and electronic smoking devices via drive-thru for safe disposal.
