



# A Proclamation

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the County Executive, Aisha N. Braveboy, for Prince George's County, Maryland, wishes to commemorate June as Flood Awareness Month; and

**WHEREAS**, Flood Awareness Month marks the beginning of hurricanes, tropical storms, tornadoes, and other related severe weather events, including the increased potential for flooding; and

**WHEREAS**, the Prince George's County Department of the Environment (DoE) has conducted floodplain studies that identify flood-prone structures throughout the County; and

**WHEREAS**, DoE is taking proactive steps to inform residents about the dangers of flooding, including preparedness measures, mitigation strategies, and available county resources; and

**WHEREAS**, it is essential to raise public awareness of floods and flood disasters, and to educate residents about the potential for flooding and how to lessen the impact of a significant flood.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, AISHA N. BRAVEBOY, COUNTY EXECUTIVE FOR PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND**, do hereby proclaim June 2026 as Flood Awareness Month in Prince George's County. **FURTHER**, I encourage all residents to familiarize themselves with the programs and services the county offers through the Department of the Environment, the Department of Public Works and Transportation, the Office of Homeland Security's Emergency Management Division, and the Police and Fire/EMS Departments, which work to protect the community from flooding and other flood-related disasters.
