Michelle Lyons called the meeting to order at 1:00 PM.

Michelle Lyons asked if any members or attendees had any comments on the cases. Gary Cunningham inquired on the scope of work for Item 2 which is on public school property.

James Crane reported this proposal was for a first-time colocation by AT&T on an existing monopole. The third-party review by CTC gave the proposal a positive recommendation. AT&T would be the fourth commercial carrier to colocate.

Gary Cunningham advised that the Prince George's County School policy was not to allow any new carriers on sites on school property.

Michelle Lyons asked for any comments by the carrier or their representatives.

Jamie Taylor from Smartlink on behalf of AT&T advised that the colocation was needed due to AT&T's ongoing deployment of FirstNet frequencies for public safety use.

Michelle Lyons asked if there were any motions regarding Item 1 and Item 3.

James Stepowany made a motion to recommend Item 1 and Item 3. Chinedu Ohanyere seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.

Michelle Lyons advised that due to the Prince George's County School policy as reported by Gary Cunningham, Item 2 could not be recommended by the committee. The carrier, its representatives, and the school representatives were advised to discuss the proposal further.

The remaining items on the agenda were administrative approvals that did not require discussion.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:09 PM.

Applications receiving a TTFCC recommendation must conform to the Building Code, the Zoning Ordinance and other applicable laws and regulations including private building restrictions, if any, which relate to the property prior to permit issuance.

All applications to be reviewed by the TTFCC Committee must be submitted by the last Wednesday of each month.

Please note that the TTFCC meetings are held on the 3rd (third) Wednesday of each month at 1:00 p.m.

Service providers must submit general location plans of facilities that are anticipated to be built in the future, to the County no later than July 31st of each year. The general location of the future facilities must be identified on a copy of the Councilmanic District Map. These yearly submissions must be sent directly to TTFCC Chairperson, Michelle Lyons, MDLyons@co.pg.md.us, at 9400 Peppercorn Place, Suite 500, Largo, Maryland 20774.

Service Providers not in compliance by the specified deadline will have future TTFCC requests placed on hold until required information is provided and accepted by the Chairperson. There are no exceptions.
