- Vote Early: June 11 – 18 from 7am–8pm every day
- Election Day: Tuesday, June 23 from 7am–8pm
- Request a mail ballot by Tuesday, June 16

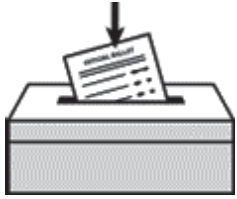
You have 3 ways to vote

Have you moved?

If you moved and haven't changed your address, you can update it during early voting. An election judge will help you change your address and give you the ballot for your new address.

Vote early in person

You can vote early **June 11 – June 18** from 7am–8pm every day. The best time to vote during early voting is on Saturday and Sunday.



Vote on Election Day June 23

Polls are open from 7am to 8pm. Anyone in line at 8pm will be allowed to vote.

Your polling place location is on the cover of this guide.



Mail-in voting

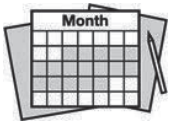
All registered voters can request a mail-in ballot:

- Online at vote.md.gov/NeedBallot before 11:59 on June 16.
- Return a paper form by email or fax before 8pm on 8:00pm June 16.
- Return a paper form in person before 8pm on June 23.
- If you want to print your ballot from a link we email to you, the deadlines are different. Find them at: vote.md.gov/MDvotes26



Return your mail-in ballot:

- By mail postmarked on or before June 23 and received by your board of elections by 10am on July 6.
- To a ballot drop box in your county before 8pm on June 23.
- In person to any polling place or early voting center by 8pm on June 23.
- In person to your Board of Elections office by 8pm on June 23



Early Voting Centers

You can vote early **June 11 – June 18** from 7am–8pm every day. The best time to vote during early voting is on Saturday and Sunday.

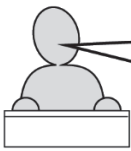

How to vote in person



Would you prefer to mark your ballot using the ballot marking device, or by hand using a pen?

I want to mark my ballot by hand

I want to use the ballot marking device

1



Get your ballot.
An election judge will give you a ballot. Take the ballot to a privacy booth.

1



Insert card.
Insert the card into the machine.

2



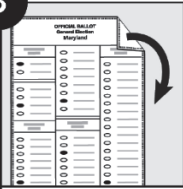
Mark your ballot.
Use the pen given to you.

2



Touch selections.
You can use your hands, the key pad and headphones, or your own accessibility device.

3



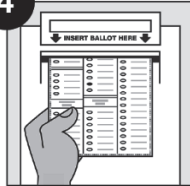
Check your ballot carefully.
If you make a mistake, ask an election judge for a new ballot.

3



Verify selections.
Review your choices on the summary screen.
If you make a mistake, you can go back and make changes.
Then, print your voted ballot.

4



Everyone casts their ballot at the scanner.
Insert your ballot into the scanner. The scanner will put it in a secure box.

You have a right to vote privately and independently.

All voting locations have an accessible touch screen voting system with:

- an audio option that reads the ballot to you
- a universal plug for personal assistive device, like a sip and puff or rocker paddle
- large print
- high contrast

Your Practice Ballot

The practice ballot, on the next page, will help prepare you to vote. This is a sample copy of your real ballot, and it includes everything you will vote on. You can bring this practice ballot with you to your polling place to help you vote.

This is a specimen ballot in accordance with election law §§ 8-102 & 9-214.

Can someone help me vote?

Yes. You can bring someone to help you vote as long as that person is not:

- Your employer or an agent of your employer
- An officer or agent of your union
- A challenger or watcher

Or, you may choose to have two election judges help you.

The person helping you must sign the Voter Assistance Form and cannot suggest how you should vote.
