



## **Selection & Placement Process**



- Applicants are applying via an age-based application
  - 14 15
  - Based on applicants age as of July 1, 2023
  - 18 22
- Applicants can apply to more than one opportunity/area of their interest.
- Applicants are filtered by their area of interest, age and program.
- The applicant list is randomized for selection.
- Applicants are placed on the Eligible List for the selected program. Once assigned to a program, they cannot be assigned to another program.
- Applicants must complete their onboarding paperwork before they are officially hired.
- Assigned lists will be sent to the Partners by May 31, 2023.

To support your organizational talent pipeline and succession planning efforts, partners may request specific youth/young adults to work with them this summer.








