Tammie Owens v. Prince George's County Department of Corrections

This case was stayed by order of the Commission on March 25, 2024 (amended March 28, 2024), before the first night of public hearing in order for the parties to proceed before the Circuit Court. This matter remains stayed before the Commission pending its adjudication before the Circuit Court.

8. APPEAL HEARING

Below is an update of petitions for judicial review of Commission decisions before the Circuit Court of Prince George's County.

a. Teonna Marshall v. Seafood Fusions, Inc (dba Hook and Reel, Inc.) HRC Case No.: HRC21-0202

This matter was scheduled to be heard March 29, 2024, was continued to May 30, 2024, and subsequently reset. The matter was heard on June 28, 2024, and the judge's

decision is pending.

b. Kevin Boatwright v. 10 Roads Express, LLC

OHR Case No.: OHR23-0605

The Executive Director filed a petition for judicial review in this matter on June 24, 2024. This matter remains pending before the Circuit Court.
