

Selection & Placement Process Update

- Youth applied to the following applications based on their age on July 1, 2025:
 - 14-15
 - 16-17
 - 18-24
- Youth ages 14-15 are only eligible for stipend-earned opportunities in the areas of Energy Conservation or Job Readiness Training.
- Youth ages 16-24 are eligible for stipends or hourly earned opportunities. Applicants selected two areas of interest for their placement. Descriptions were provided in the application.
- Applicants are placed on the Eligible List based on meeting program eligibility requirements.
- Youth are then assigned using the requested youth list or by random selection to their areas of interests.
- Offer letters will be sent by May 2, 2025. Youth will have one (1) week to respond to their offer. If they fail to respond, they will forfeit the offer.
- Once youth are assigned, they cannot be reassigned.
- Applicants must complete their onboarding paperwork before they are officially hired.



Selection & Placement Process Update (cont.)

Placement Request Update:

- Partner Participation Survey Deadline: January 31, 2025.
- We are working closely to fulfill the number of youth requested to partners that submitted information by the deadline.
- Our ability to fulfill requests submitted after the deadline is limited due to funding constraints.
- We are actively working within our forecasted budget to diversify the types of experiences offered this summer and will confirm your organization's approved number in May.

Selection & Placement Process Update (cont.)

Your partnership plays a critical role in providing meaningful work experiences to young people in our community, and we are grateful for your commitment and patience.

- All parents/guardians of selected youth will be advised to read through the resource guide.
