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#### **WELCOME AND ROLL CALL**

Chair Davall called the meeting to order at 6:43 p.m. Roll Call was taken.

#### **ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA**

#### **SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS AND UPDATES**

##### **Appointments and Nominations**

Vice Chair Sanchez reported that the Subcommittee did not meet this month.



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### **Community Outreach**

Board Member Bryant led the Board discussion about upcoming outreach efforts, including a tentatively confirmed virtual meeting scheduled for May 20, 2026, with the Commission for Individuals with Disabilities.

The Board discussed hosting a community outreach event at a County library (to be determined) and agreed to hold the event on Wednesday, June 24, 2026, at 6:30p.m., in Councilmanic District 6 and/or 8. Board Members and local law enforcement agencies will be invited to attend. The event will include a Board presentation, followed by a panel discussion and an opportunity for attendees to ask questions. Board Member Bryant will work with Staff on logistics for the event.

### **Data Analysis**

Board Member Coleman proposed the development of an online dashboard to be updated on a regular basis. Board Member Coleman reviewed the current dashboard available on the PAB's website and identified opportunities for improvement, including the addition of more comprehensive data points. Board Member Coleman will collaborate with Program Administrator Ebony Rorls to implement updates and expand the dashboard's functionality.

Christal Ogene, Policy Analyst, thanked the Board for its review and input on relevant legislation from the Maryland General Assembly during the previous meeting. Ms. Ogene advised that the Board's positions have been submitted to the Office of Legislative Affairs.

Vice Chair Sanchez inquired about the status of new Police Accountability Board Member appointments from the County Executive and County Council. Christal Ogene, Policy Analyst, advised that the Inspector General is coordinating with officials regarding these appointments.

Board Member Melton discussed the development of Quarterly Chief Meeting Questions, a process he has managed previously, with the Board reviewing and approving the final questions. He invited Board Members to participate in the process or if needed inquired about forming a Subcommittee to assist. Board Member Melton is happy to continue serving in this capacity if there are no interested parties.

### **Meeting Frequency**

The Board discussed the merits of holding meetings once per month versus twice per month. Given the current four vacancies, the Board voted to meet once monthly and revisit once all vacancies have been filled. The second monthly meeting date may be used for Subcommittee Meetings, Events, Chief Meetings or other purposes. The next Board Meeting is scheduled for April 8, 2026.

Vice Chair Sanchez offered a motion to establish a once-per-month meeting schedule, to be held on the second Wednesday of each month until additional Board Members are appointed, beginning April 8, 2026. The motion was seconded by Board Member Springs.

Board Members provided feedback on the previous Quarterly Chief Meeting, agreeing to: remain mindful of time, limit follow-up questions to one from a selected Board Member, and stay focused during discussions.
