### **Maryland Statewide Police Accountability Board Summit**

Board Member O'Neal also reported on his attendance at the Statewide Police Accountability Board Summit hosted by Baltimore City. Discussions included:

- Operational successes and challenges among Maryland PABs
- Differences between large and small jurisdictions
- Legislative recommendations for strengthening PAB authority statewide
- Training limitations and delays for Administrative Charging Committee members due to scheduling constraints
- Funding challenges affecting future statewide collaboration efforts

Board members discussed:

- Challenges faced by smaller jurisdictions in implementing police accountability reforms
- Structural and funding limitations in certain county governments
- The importance of continued statewide collaboration and information sharing

### **Commission for Individuals with Disabilities Presentation**

Program Associate Allen reminded the Board that they are scheduled to present at the Commission for Individuals with Disabilities virtual meeting on Wednesday, May 20, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. Board Members O'Neal and Coleman offered to present together. Program Associate Allen will send the Zoom Link and updated PowerPoint to the Board.

### **Data Analysis**

Board Member Coleman reported that she will work with staff to obtain annual report data following the upcoming quarterly Chiefs Meeting. She anticipates presenting data trends and analysis during a future Board meeting later in the summer.

Board Member Coleman also proposed coordinating a meeting between the Data Analysis and Cases and Complaints subcommittees to discuss identifying trends within complaint data. Board Member Coleman will schedule a time to meet with subcommittee members.

### **Legislation and Recommendations**

Vice Chair Sanchez will work with Policy Analyst Ogene to coordinate future meetings regarding legislative work and citizen feedback previously shared by staff.

### **Quarterly Chiefs Meeting Questions**

Board Member Melton led a discussion regarding potential discussion topics and questions for the upcoming Chiefs Meeting scheduled for May 27, 2026. Mr. Melton agreed to draft proposed Chiefs Meeting questions and circulate them to the Board for review by Thursday, May 21, 2026, with the goal of staff sending those questions to police chiefs no later than Friday, May 22, 2026.
