Prince George's County is faring about the same as the average county in Maryland for Population Health and Well-being, and better than the average county in the nation.

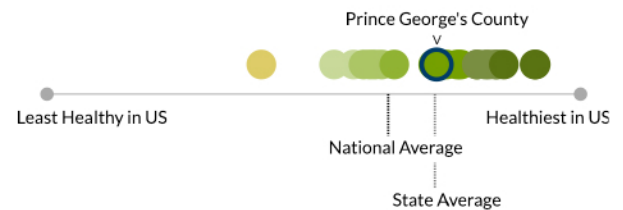

Prince George's County is faring about the same as the average county in Maryland for Community Conditions, and better than the average county in the nation.

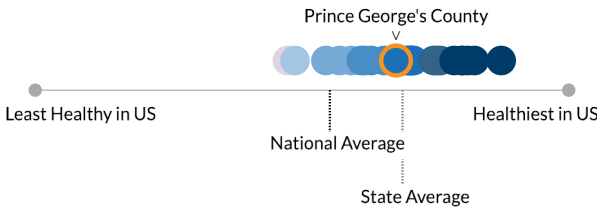
