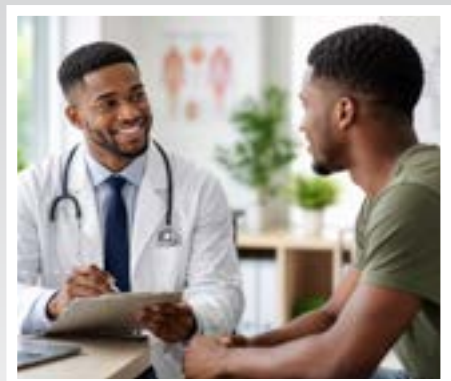

The Bridge Center at Adam's House is a central and accessible location for residents to receive services that support positive community reintegration and promote productive community life that reduces recidivism rates and improves health outcomes
