## DEPARTMENT OF PERMITTING, INSPECTIONS AND ENFORCEMENT

Sec. 13-231: For the purposes of this ordinance, abandoned vehicle shall mean any motor vehicle or trailer that is inoperable and left unattended on private or public property for more than forty-eight (48) hours, or does not display current license plates for that vehicle, is wrecked or dismantled.

#### **REVENUE AUTHORITY**

Sec. 26-127.04 (c)(18): Stopping, standing, or parking prohibited in specified places — (Lawn): (c) Standing or parking. No person shall stand or park a vehicle; (18) On an unpaved area of a residential lot.

### PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT

The Police Department may exercise all the powers and functions granted to it by State law and the Prince George's County Code regarding parking enforcement matters.
