The proposed system shall include Artificial Intelligence (AI) and/or Machine Learning (ML) capabilities that are embedded within the core platform. The system shall support continuous learning and ongoing model improvement based on new and evolving data inputs.

Enforcement Optimization

The system shall provide AI-driven predictive analytics to identify high-probability violation zones based on historical, temporal, and spatial data. The system shall support optimization of enforcement deployment, including recommended patrol routes and scheduling.

Revenue and Payment Optimization

The system shall include predictive modeling to assess the likelihood of citation payment and non-payment and utilize integrated payment data to generate behavioral insights and improve overall compliance strategies.

Operational Intelligence and Customer Experience

The system shall include automated anomaly detection capabilities to identify irregular patterns in citation issuance, payment activity, and overall system usage.

The system may include virtual assistant or chatbot functionality to support customer inquiries related to citations, payments, and permits.
