De Guzman has more than 35 years of experience in Prince George's County government. His most recent responsibilities included responsibility for the review and permitting of all bridge and roadway construction, roadway improvements, storm drain infrastructure, stormwater management and flood mitigation facilities and policies, floodplain management and more. He also serves on many technical and policy entities in the establishment of regulations, process development, and code changes.

His achievements include the National Capital Business Park; National Harbor; MGM National Harbor; Suitland Town Center; the University of Maryland Capital Region Medical Center in Largo; FedEx Field; Konterra Town Center; and the establishment of DPIE itself.
