- <u>40-23:</u> 6808 Brownwood Road Shirley Lathern Ongoing parties and events, distribution of food and alcohol, ticket sales, loud noise and music, trash & debris, large number of attendees
- <u>41-23: 9619 Geena Nicole Drive Shirley Lathern</u>
 Ongoing parties and events, trash & debris, loud noise and music, large number of attendees, ticket sales, distribution of food & alcohol

The board unanimously voted to declare case **40-23**, **6808** Brownwood Road, a public and neighborhood nuisance; ordered to cease and desist all nuisance activities that constitute a nuisance, immediate compliance ordered.
