

Sidewalk Snow & Ice Removal Inspection Program

- ❄ Owners, managers and tenants of residential and commercial properties abutting sidewalks near public roadways are responsible for removing snow and ice within 48 hours after it has accumulated to two inches or more.
- ❄ Those not removing snow/ice from sidewalks within 24 hours after the end of the snowstorm will receive a reminder notice.
- ❄ Those not clearing the sidewalks within 48 hours after the end of the snowstorm may be issued a citation for a fine of \$100.
- ❄ After the first citation, a fine of \$100 per day may be assessed until the snow/ice is cleared. The County can remove the snow and assess the owner if the snow is not cleared.
- ❄ Be a good neighbor! Clear your sidewalks. Assist neighbors who are unable to remove snow/ice from their sidewalks.
