### Snow and Ice Control Operations



When a snow emergency is declared, the Prince George's County Department of Public Works and Transportation (DPW&T) is responsible for providing "passable" conditions over a network of more

than 2,000 miles of County maintained roadways. Treating roadways consists of plowing and/or salting, as warranted by weather conditions.

# What to Expect During a Snow Emergency Event

- \* Parking is prohibited along all designated snow emergency routes.
- \* Residents should park in driveways.
- \* If on-street parking is necessary, parking is permitted only on the even-numbered side of the street. Abandoned vehicles will be towed.
- \* Once the road has been treated and plowed, cars should be moved to the odd side of the street.
- ★ Failure to comply could result in fines and/or towing.
- \* Primary roads will be plowed and treated during active snowfall. Once the snow stops, resources will move into residential areas.
- \* To avoid shoveling the driveway multiple times, please shovel after the street has been plowed.

For snow removal requests, call PGC311 - 24 HOURS AFTER THE SNOW HAS ENDED.

# Snow Operations Deploy Based on Weather Conditions

**Snowflake/DPW&T Only** - Salting operation with less than 2 inches of snow.

TRAVEL LANES ARE FREE OF SNOW AND ICE

**Modified** - Plowing operation of 2-4 inches of snow and limited contractor support.

**Full** - Plowing over multiple days with contractor support with 4+ inches of snow.

**Blizzard** - Full operation with full contractor support and heavy equipment.

DPW&T PLOWS TO COMPLETE ROAD CONDITION, EXCEPT FOR BLIZZARD CONDITIONS.

### Working Together: How You Can Prepare For Snow

- \* Park on the even numbered sides of residential streets or in driveways.
- \* Contact the appropriate health provider for dialysis treatments.
- \* Pick up any required medications.
- \* Have a supply of rock salt, cat litter or sand available.
- \* Have your heating fuel level checked and filled, if needed.
- \* Have flashlights, extra batteries, a battery operated radio, and fresh bottled water on hand.
- \* Keep a stock of packaged foods that don't need refrigeration and may be prepared without electrical power.
- \* Please check on vulnerable residents and senior citizens in your community as winter conditions can cause a wide range of injuries and illnesses.
- \* Trash, recycling, and yard waste pickup may be impacted during snow events.

# The Bus

During snow events, TheBus service levels are:

**Snowflake/DPW&T Only:** TheBus routes servicing hilly areas will be detoured to main roads, all other routes will run normally. Paratransit: All reservations maintained.

**Modified:** Routes in residential areas, regardless of terrain, will detour to main roads. Paratransit: Dialysis subscriptions only.

**Full:** Routes suspended except for those servicing main roadways/emergency routes (i.e. Route 17).

Paratransit: Dialysis subscriptions only.

**Blizzard:** All routes suspended due to impassable roadways. Paratransit: All service cancelled.
