election@co.pg.md.us**Prince George's County Board of Elections Announces Delay in Specimen Ballot Mailing**

Prince George's County Board of Elections announced today that the local distribution of physical specimen ballots for the 2026 Primary Election is successfully underway across the county. Following minor logistical adjustments at the printing level, the U.S. Postal Service began processing and shipping the ballots out in continuous waves starting on Wednesday, June 10, 2026.

Local election officials have confirmed that voters across Prince George's County began receiving their physical specimen ballots in their home mailboxes on Friday, June 12, 2026.

Because residential mail delivery schedules vary by postal route, residents who have not yet received their packet can expect it to arrive over the next few days. The Board of Elections emphasizes that this staggered delivery schedule does not impact voting security, voter deadlines, or your ability to cast a ballot.

Ongoing early voting (running daily through Thursday, June 18, 2026) and the primary election day on Tuesday, June 23, 2026, are proceeding completely on schedule.

To help manage resident expectations, the Board wishes to clarify that voters who have already requested a Mail-In Ballot or a Print-at-Home ballot will not be sent a specimen ballot. These voters receive their official voting materials directly, removing the need for a duplicate sample mailing. The physical mailings that began rolling out on June 10 apply exclusively to registered residents who plan to vote in person and have not requested a mail-in option.

Immediate Alternative Access Points for Voters

If you are planning to vote early this week and prefer not to wait for your paper copy to arrive in the mail, you can access your identical ballot information immediately via these resources:

- **Online Voter Lookup (Instant Access):** Both in-person and mail-in voters can view, download, or print their exact, personalized sample ballot right now by using the Maryland State Board of Elections Voter Lookup tool online at elections.mypgc.us or elections.maryland.gov.
- **In-Person Inspection:** Printed reference copies of all county precinct ballot styles are available for public viewing at the Prince George's County Board of Elections headquarters, located at 1100 Mercantile Lane, Suite 115A, Largo, MD 20774.
- **Telephone Assistance:** Residents with specific questions regarding their voter registration status, household mail status, or assigned voting centers can speak directly to a local representative by calling 301-341-7300, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM.
