

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”), will be held on **Friday, July 17, 2026, at 4:00 p.m. eastern standard time** by The Housing Authority of Prince George’s County (the “Issuer”), a public body corporate and politic organized and existing under the Housing Authorities Law being Division II of the Housing and Community Development Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland (the “Act”). As permitted by Internal Revenue Service Revenue Procedure 2022-2, promulgated pursuant to the Code, the official public hearing will be held via telephone conference using the following conference call information: toll-free number 1-877-309-2073, access code 813-292-141. The public hearing concerns the proposed incurrence by the Issuer of one or more series of tax-exempt indebtedness (the “Obligations”), pursuant to a plan of financing, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$20,000,000. The proceeds of the Obligations are expected to finance the acquisition and construction of a 158-unit multifamily rental “housing project,” as defined under the Act, located at 210 Maryland Park Drive, Capitol Heights, Prince George’s County, Maryland, known or to be known at 210 On the Park (the “Project”), including, without limitation, the costs of issuance of the Obligations. The Project will be jointly owned, operated and/or managed by Smith & Henzy Affordable Group and Community First Development Corporation, or an affiliate thereof.

The Obligations will constitute special limited obligations of the Issuer. The principal of, premium (if any), and interest on the Obligations shall never constitute the debt, or indebtedness, or liability, of Prince George’s County, Maryland (the “County”), the State of Maryland (the “State”) or any political subdivision of the State within the meaning of any provision of the Constitution of the State and shall not constitute nor give rise to a pecuniary liability or a charge

against the general credit or taxing powers of the Issuer, the County, or the State or any political subdivision of the State, but shall be payable solely from the sources provided for in the proceedings for the issuance of the Obligations. The Issuer has no taxing power.

At the time set for the public hearing, interested persons will be given the opportunity to express their views, both orally (via toll-free telephone conference) and in writing, on the proposed Obligations, the Project, the location and nature of the facilities to be financed or refinanced, and the plan of financing for the Project. Members of the public may attend, listen to and contribute to any discussion during the hearing by utilizing the hearing information set forth in the first paragraph of this notice.

Persons wishing to participate may submit a written request to Michael Jackson, Sr., Project Manager, at mjackson2@co.pg.md.us by 4:00 PM, eastern standard time, on Wednesday, July 15, 2026. The hearing officer will also provide a time for additional comments at the end of the public hearing.
