THIRD PARTY UTILITY/ROADWAY RESTORATION INDEPENDENT INSPECTOR APPLICATION GUIDELINES and/or UTILITY COMPANY PROGRAM APPROVAL

Applicants or utility companies seeking approval to conduct third-party utility/roadway restoration inspections on approved projects within the Third-Party Inspection Program (TPIP) must provide the following documentation:

- 1. Letter of request to conduct third-party utility/roadway restoration inspections on approved TPIP projects; or have submitted a Utility company program plan for approval.
- 2. Résumé detailing utility/roadway restoration work experience and utility/roadway restoration inspection history (one or two condensed pages to show subject only is acceptable). Not applicable for approved Utility company program plans.
- 3. Minimum qualifications: 3 years' experience with Mid-Atlantic Region Certified Technician or equivalent in its three subfields of Asphalt, Concrete and Soils. Knowledge of engineering properties of construction materials used in roads and related civil engineering projects, and knowledge of testing specifications, practices, methods, and materials evaluation is required; or prior Utility company program plan.
- 4. Any field inspector other than a Mid-Atlantic Region Certified Technician or equivalent; or an individual included in an approved Utility company program plan. He/she shall have a minimum of 5 years' experience; is employed by and has demonstrated to a Mid-Atlantic Region Certified Technician or a professional licensed engineer in the State of Maryland as having enough skill, knowledge, and competency to identify discrepancies in the three subfields of Asphalt, Concrete and Soils; and to be under the direct supervision of/or equivalent to a Mid-Atlantic Region Technician or a professional licensed engineer in the State of Maryland.
- 5. Independent Third-Party Agencies, and non self-insured need copies of Certificates of Insurance to include: Workers' Compensation, Comprehensive Bodily Injury, Property Damage Liability, Automobile, and Professional Liability.
