

Which Vehicles Are in Violation?

County Code Regulates Vehicles in Residential Zones



The Code **DISALLOWS**:

- ✗ Vehicles printed with advertising messages exceeding 4-inches in height
- ✗ Dump trucks, cranes, tow trucks, trucks with dual axels and trucks with a stake platform parked in driveways
- ✗ Vehicle repair, other than minor owner maintenance, in garages, driveways, yards, streets, cul-de-sacs and other residential areas
- ✗ Semi-truck trailers and semi-truck trailer cabs
- ✗ Any wrecked, dismantled or unlicensed trucks and other vehicles
- ✗ Car trailers parked in driveways, yards and other residential areas
- ✗ Vehicles parked on unpaved surfaces

The Code **ALLOWS**:

- ✓ Work trucks less than 8,500 lbs. used for business affixed with ladders and some construction equipment
- ✓ One commercial vehicle less than 17,000 lbs. stored in an enclosed garage
- ✓ Commercial vehicles less than 8,500 lbs. with markings less than 4-inches in height
- ✓ Camping and boat trailers as defined by Maryland State Police



DPIE handles vehicle complaints on private property. Revenue Authority handles complaints on streets.
