This checklist identifies submittal requirements for Site Development Concept Plan Review.

Site Development Concept Approval is required for all projects, except for work associated with minor residential modifications with less than 5000 sf of disturbance.

		provide list of parties actually notified. Also provide M-NCPPC approved list of parties to notify.
