





PROJECT OBJECTIVES & COMMUNITY CONCERNS

OBJECTIVES

- Traffic Calming with the use of central grass medians, curb extensions at intersections, and choker islands
- Minimize disruption to on-street parking
- Maintain outer curb lines
- Maintain access to properties

CONCERNS ADDRESSED

- Speeding along the corridor and the observed use of the center turn lane for passing
- Failed Pavement
- Upheaval of sidewalk
- Bradford Pear Trees



PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS




- Repair existing failed roadway and repave entire length of Montpelier Drive
- Replace deteriorated concrete curb, sidewalk, ADA compliant ramps, and driveways aprons
- Raised Grass Medians, Curb Extensions at Intersections, and Choker Islands
- New roadway pavement markings defining travel lanes, in-road bicycle lanes, curbside parking, and new roadway signs
- Select new drainage inlets and roadway underdrains
- Removal and replacement of Bradford Pear trees with new trees
- Installation of LED Street Lights on Montpelier Drive



RAISED GRASS MEDIAN – 10-FEET WIDE








CURB EXTENSIONS AT INTERSECTIONS






TREE REMOVAL AND PLANTING

- Total Plantings (3" caliper)
 - 189 trees of 11 different species
